

Activity 3



Our Daily Bread Collage

When we pray the prayer that Jesus taught his disciples, we pray that we will be given our daily bread. As the children consider the hunger and poverty in the world, they can be reminded of Jesus' prayer as well as the need to provide for everyone with the words: Give us – all of us – our daily bread.

Materials

- photos of people of many kinds from magazines and newspapers (you may wish to have a large number and variety of photos already cut from various sources so the children can choose from them)
- photographs of church members (a church directory that can be cut up) or have the children take some at an earlier time)
- poster board
- white glue
- scissors
- dark construction paper



Directions

- 1** Have the children gather photographs of all kinds of people and arrange them on the poster board. Include people the children know as well as their own photographs to make the collage more engaging. Before they glue the photographs down, look together at the people represented. Ask the group if there are groups of people who are not shown on the collage. If they see some who are missing, have them search the photographs again.
- 2** Once everyone is satisfied, glue the photographs to the poster board.
- 3** Photocopy the letter patterns on the back of this page directly to sheets of dark construction paper or cut the letters from the photocopy and use them as templates to cut the letters from dark paper. Arrange the letters on the poster to spell “Give us – all of us – our daily bread.”
